INTERSEGMENTAL GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM 2021 - 2022 ADVISING FORM

Completion of the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) ensures that a student does not need to take additional lower-division general education courses to satisfy campus general education requirements.

Courses used for certification must be completed with grades "C" or better, and be a minimum of 3 semester units. A course cannot be certified unless it was on the IGETC list during the year in which it was taken by the student. Students beginning in Fall 2021 must follow the 2021-2022 IGETC requirements.

Partial IGETC certification is allowed with a maximum of two courses missing, which have to be completed after transfer. Students need Areas 1 and 2 to meet minimum transfer admission requirements. Partial certification acknowledging a deficiency in Area 1 and/or Area 2 may also indicate a student does not meet the minimum transfer requirements.
