



Please take the following into consideration with service animals

- Service animals are not therapy dogs or pets – they have been trained to perform a **task** related to a person's disability.
- Service animals must either be on a leash or must be seated on their owner's lap and are not permitted on furniture, table tops, or chairs.
- Service animals must be housebroken and clean, must not be causing a disruption by barking, whimpering, growling, or running around, and cannot be making a disruption through behavior uncharacteristic of a service animal.
- Service animals that are out of control may be asked to leave the building.
