### TRANSFER BASICS

### What Does it Mean to Transfer?

"Transfer" indicates moving from one educational institution to another. We use the term "transfer" to describe advancement from Barstow Community College to a 4-year university.

#### What do I Need to do to Transfer?

- Plan a program of study with your counselor
- Work hard and do well in your courses-FOCUS ON GPA
- Complete English & Math requirements EARLY.

### **How Long Does it Take to Transfer?**

- Generally 2-3 years
- Several factors will impact the length of time you are at BCC: English and Math placement, selected major, number of units taken per semester, and academic progress.

# UCRIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA INTERITY OF CALIFORNIA



The University of California, Riverside is one of 10 universities within the prestigious University of California system, and the only UC located in Inland Southern California.

Widely recognized as one of the most ethnically diverse research universities in the nation, UCR currently hosts about 22,000 students, with 900 instructional faculty.

UCR currently offers more than 80 majors and 536 student organizations/clubs.

### **Basic Requirements For Transfer:**

- You must complete 60 semester (90 quarter) units of transferable college credit with a minimum GPA of 2.4 (California residents) or 2.8 (nonresidents).
- Admission is selective. Strive to surpass the minimum GPA.
- Some major programs require a minimum GPA that is higher than that of basic admission.
- No more than 14 semester (21 quarter) units may be Pass/Not Pass.

### **CAREER SPOTLIGHT— Administration of Justice**

### What Can You Do with a Degree in Administration of Justice?

Administration of Justice degrees are typically available at the associate's degree and bachelor's degree levels. Many careers, such as those that involve the courts, law, forensics and advanced crime investigation often require graduate degrees in criminal justice or forensics. Administration of justice degrees can be used as a stepping stone on the path to such professions. Other options for a graduate with an administration of justice degree include careers in forensics or law, but these normally require further education at the master's or doctoral level.



### **Career Options**

Administration of Justice degrees typically lead to careers that fall within two categories: law enforcement or corrections. Some examples of law enforcement careers are police officers and detectives. Parole officers fall within the corrections category and may be a good career choice for candidates with a bachelor's degree in administration of justice, because this field requires a four year degree.
