 - No public comments were made on February 23, 2017.
- V. Items of Business: [Discussion and Action Items]
 - **A.** Tonia Teresh, Dean of Student Success and Equity, will discuss the Food Pantry. Discussion Item. (President Moreno).
 - Tonia: Student equity is funding the Food Pantry, since we found out about it late last year. This is a statewide categorical funding, which means this type of funding is meant to go to exact programs and services. We want to track the exact number of students who use this service to provide proof incase there ever is auditing. I need ASG to retroactively go back and take the number of people that been served and create a spreadsheet on how many people have used this service. I would also like to see a list of items as well. An issue that is occurring is that people have been using the food whenever they wish when it is suppose to be only for the event day. I want a spreadsheet once a semester with the day of the Food Pantry event, number served, and what items they receive to see what

- works. I only want the numbers of people served, so do not send names. Keep on helping Joann in getting the food.
- **B.** Discussion regarding ASG Bylaws and Constitution alterations. Discussion Item. (Secretary Frias).
- **Kevin:** Here is a first reading and alteration of the ASG Bylaws, so please take a look over it. Joshua has informed me that there are other mistakes in the document such as there being claims about Senate meetings and an ASG Handbook that does not exist, which I will fix for my next presentation. I mostly focused on only rules at this time. If any of you notice errors or have concerns, please let me know.

- A. Approval of sponsoring Alpha Gamma Sigma Club Members to attend the 91st
 AGS State Convention in Ontario, California April 21-23, 2017. Total fees \$1,465

- Discussion:

Eduardo: We have been part of AGS since 1962. This is an important part of AGS, since originally we were in the red, but we have been doing very well. **Sui:** We have issues with the rooms and sexes.

Joshua: I believe that only 2 officers should go, which both of them are male.

Eduardo: Currently, the room setups do not work with 3 males and 1 female.

Joshua: My suggestion would be the cheapest.

Aylin: This should be invested in students that are not graduating, so that they can pass on the information. The only thing we want is for only 4 people to go.

Dr. Dadabhoy: We cannot require people to share rooms. We have to be careful about gender identity.

Tonia: Taking only gender into account for setting up the rooms does not consider a person's own gender identity and their sexual orientation.

Aylin: We could just have them sign a form of consent.

Eduardo: We should send 4 people and an advisor for a total of \$1,465.

Joshua: What stops other clubs from asking us to give them money, so that they can go to their conferences as well?

Dr. Dadabhoy: This is not your money. This is the student's money.

Eduardo: Many AGS's send many of their students to these conferences, up to 20 sometimes.

Aylin: We gone to conferences where other schools sent all of their ASG. We do not need four people to bring back information.

Ariana: Conferences bring back more than information. It lets students have experiences.

Aylin: My main point still stands, that this is meant to enhance clubs.
