Day of Remembrance Memorial Planned Sept. 11 at Barstow Community College

Barstow, Calif. – (Aug. 31, 2007) The Associated Student Body (ASB) of Barstow Community College cordially invite the public to attend and participate in a "Day of Remembrance" memorial tribute to mark the sixth anniversary of the Sept. 11 attacks on the World Trade Center. The one-hour ceremony, which begins at 9 a.m., will feature presentations by the Barstow Fire Protection District, the Barstow Police Department, the California Highway Patrol (CHP), and Sheriff's Department and more. The Lion's Club of Barstow will commemorate the event by placing the American Flag along Main Street and Barstow Road throughout the city.

The memorial event will begin with a joint Color Guard presentation by the Marine Corps Logistic Base, and the U.S. Army, Navy and Coast Guard. The ceremony includes a welcome address by the BCC president, the national anthem, lowering of the flag, a testimony of a Army soldier from Ft. Irwin, proclamation by the mayor and speech by the Barstow Fire Chief.

The City of Barstow will have a voter's registration table available for the public. ASB will sponsor a table for those that wish to write letters to active duty military personnel.
