“Annie” began its production debut on Broadway in 1977 and has been around the world during its more than three decade production stint. “Annie” takes place during the winter of 1933 amidst the Great Depression. Annie is a fiery young orphan girl who must live in a miserable orphanage run by the tyrannical Miss Hannigan. Her seemingly hopeless situation changes dramatically when she is selected to spend a short time at the residence of the wealthy munitions industrialist, Oliver Warbucks.
