A team went to SVHS on 1/21/15 to assist the seniors in completing their student success steps. Fifteen students signed up but only seven students participate. Dates for Baker High School and Excelsior have been set for February and March. BHS has been a little more challenging, Mr. Eaton made contact with Mr. Delton and dates for the outreach process are being proposed.

Aid for School Program Update

Thirty eight students were accepted for the initial group. Two students may fall into the foster youth category. Heather suggested that the program refer to the Chancellor's office definition of foster youth to confirm their status. In speaking with the students there are some who have a greater need. They are being evaluated on a case by case basis to see if additional accommodations can be made for them. A second application period will begin March 1st to allow students who start classes on March 23rd. Twenty five additional students can be accepted to the program at that time.

Student Center

The budget could double if the Governor's budget is approved. The additional funds plan on being used to best serve the students. A proposal was submitted to change the IPAC into a Student Success Center for the Title V grant. The College did not receive the grant but the information was repurposed for the student success and equity funds. Kim proposed an overview of the center. The committee agreed that it was not feasible to combine Tutorial and the Transfer Center. Since the Transfer Center will continue to stay in their current location the Veteran's Center would have to find a new home. Gene suggested that a new location be found for the Veteran's Center with a place to smoke before moving them out. Rick also suggested to open the back of the IPAC to initiate better flow for people coming on campus and using the information center.

The accelerated program will shorten the developmental sequences in Math and English courses by reviewing the curriculum to teach what is necessary to succeed in the courses.
