Persistence and Poverty

Hypotheses

- 1. There is a disproportionately high percentage of single mothers in the Barstow area.
- 2. Due to the lack of training and education, a majority of these single-mother families are living in poverty.
- 3. In order to make a living and support their families, post-secondary education often becomes a lower priority.
- 4. As a result, we see a lower persistence among 20-24 year-old females.

Marital Status

- There are no significant differences between Barstow and statewide in marital status
- Males are almost identical
- There are about 5% more married females statewide as compared to Barstow.
