

SAP Status

To be eligible for financial aid, students are required by the U.S. Department of Education and the State of California to maintain satisfactory academic progress toward completing their program of study.

To satisfy academic progress requirements, students must:

- **Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0**
- **Complete 67% of all units attempted (including transferred units and units attempted while not receiving financial aid)**
- **Complete their program of study within 150% of the published program length (typically 90 units for an Associate degree)**

If a student's GPA is less than 2.0 they are put on Academic Probation

If a student has not completed the necessary 67% of attempted units for the semester they are put on a Progress Probation

Once a student attempts 90 units they become ineligible

If a student is dismissed from financial aid because they had two semesters where they did not meet SAP they are dismissed and become ineligible for financial aid

****Once a student has attempted 90 units or is put on a dismissal status they are ineligible to receive financial aid until they go through the appeal process. If the appeal is approved then the student can continue to receive financial aid while their SAP status is being monitored****
