CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION 2020 - 2021 CERTIFICATION COURSE PATTERN

Each candidate for the bachelor's degree from a CSU institution shall complete a pattern of general education courses which total a minimum of 48 semester units. BCC may certify a maximum of 39 semester units toward meeting this requirement; the remaining 9 semester units must be compoleted at the CSU at the upper-division level.

A course may be used in only one area of the CSU GE certification and must be on the approved list in the year completed. Coursework used to fulfill areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

Courses count in one area only. Full general education certification from BCC requires a minimum of 39 units distributed as follows:
