B) Summarize the progress you have made on Program Level Outcomes (PLOs):

Faculty have incorporated studies to encompass book reviews, thesis and minor dissertation projects in addition to the perfunctory term project assessments. Foreign language acquisition encouraged as are projects necessitating advanced research and presentation skills. In targeting PLO outcomes, department measures student attainment of PLOs through discussions about student performance in research activities and by comparison of data gathered on examinations and other student tasks.

C) Summarize the progress you have made on course level outcomes and assessments (SLOs):

Department has synthesized the way in which student outcomes of success are attained utilizing rubric which has been agreed upon by faculty. Continued improvement noted in learning objectives given faculty continue providing projects, course assignments (in and outside of classroom) and academic research integral for student success. Success rates indicate 59.67% for traditional classroom delivery with online underperforming at a rate of 54.19. The below average performance for Online may be attributed to rigor of program, faculty participation rate in online program and student attrition.

D) Describe any program, course, and/or instructional changes made by your program as a result of the outcomes assessment process.

In hopes of increasing student retention post census for 70%, or better, success rate, faculty will incorporate learning modules emphasizing study skills, group participation, and research development. Coordination between faculty regarding research projects, field trips to local and regional museums, and in accordance with campus wide lectures hope to improve our delivery model and student success rate. Once more, our program has increased the frequency of course offerings necessary for transfer degree in history.

E) Reflecting on the responses for B) and C) above, what will you implement for the next assessment cycle?

Research skills development exposing students to campus library resource tools should enhance historical examination expertise. Faculty will develop study modules whereby students will follow a rubric designed for successful course completion. Continued improvement upon these models for transfer purposes. Having witnessed interest in the transfer program, department has created History Club for BCC in hopes of garnering more interest and support for program. Furthermore, implementation of such programs enhances the attainment of SLOs for all courses throughout the program.
