



#### **Average Cumulative GPA-All Students**



Success rates in traditionally taught courses (face-to-face) were 12% higher than overall success rates. Retention rates in these same classes were 2.5% lower than overall retention rates. The data shows that retention is better in online courses however, success rates are lower.
