WHAT IS BSEP?

Basic Skills Education Program (BSEP) is an **intensive** <u>REFRESHER</u> course that will prepare you to take the Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT). The goal is to increase your GT score to a 110 or higher.

How Can I Enroll?

- □ STEP 1: <u>TABE TUESDAYS</u>. Take a pre-assessment test: TABE 11M (Reading and Mathematics) to establish your baseline prior to the course. Walk-in testing is available at the Education Center on <u>Tuesdays</u> at **0800** and **1300**. Soldier must register with Barstow Community College prior to taking the TABE test. Registration and testing can take up to 3 hours.
- □ STEP 2: Receive enrollment packet. Forms will require Company Commander's approval.
- STEP 3: Complete and return enrollment packet to secure a seat. FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED!
- ☐ STEP 4: Receive confirmation email of class date, time, and expectations.

COURSE EXPECTATIONS

- ☐ Attendance is **MANDATORY**. If you miss the first day, you will be dropped from the course.
- ☐ Homework is **MANDATORY**. Failure to complete assignments will result in being dropped from the class.
- Duty Uniform is to be worn everyday as this course will be your place of duty. No PTs or civilian clothing.
- □ No Cell Phone use permitted during the class.
- ☐ Tutoring is available four times a week immediately after class Monday-Thursday. You are <u>required</u> to attend twice a week for the three-week course. Tutoring is required all four days for any two-week course.
- ☐ Class is not held on Saturday or Sunday, but you will be assigned homework over the weekend. Plan to study and work on homework EVERY weekend. Course is expected to be treated as a TDY assignment.
- ☐ Do not schedule appointments during class time. You will NOT be excused from class for an appointment.

PLEASE NOTE:

Once you take the AFCT, the results will be your <u>new line scores</u> regardless of if your scores have increased or decreased. There is a waiting period of **6 months** to retake the AFCT.
