Scholarship Specifics:

1. The recipient must have a Music Major and pursue a teaching credential in that major.
2. The scholarship is for fall enrollment in a four-year college/university.
3. The CalRTA Tumbleweed Division #74 Goodin Scholarship amount is \$2,000.
4. The scholarship will be paid to the recipient for books, supplies, and college fees.
5. The funds will be paid directly to the student after written confirmation of enrollment in the four-year college/university.
6. The recipient must be a resident of the High Desert.

Requirements:

1. The applicant must currently be a full-time, BBC student with 12 units or more this semester and qualify to graduate with an A.A. by the end of the spring semester.
2. The recipient must enroll in a four-year college/university the following fall term.
3. The recipient must present a Letter of Acceptance by June 1, of the year, to receive the award. All correspondence must be mailed to the CalRTA Tumbleweed Division No. 74 Scholarship Committee Member found at the end of this application. The application is due April 15.
4. Verification of enrollment in a four-year college/university must be provided to the CalRTA Tumbleweed Division Scholarship Committee Member, listed at the end of the application, by October 15, of the year of the award. If this is not accomplished by the appropriate date, the award will be forfeited.
