Be a resident of the High Desert

- 1. The recipient must be pursuing a teaching or school counseling degree/credential.
- 2. The scholarship is for fall enrollment in a four-year college/university.
- 3. The Carolyn L. Whaley Scholarship amount is \$2,000.
- 4. The funds will be paid directly to the student after written confirmation of enrollment in the college/university.

Requirements:

- 1. The applicant must currently be a full-time, BCC student with 12 units or more this semester and qualify to graduate with an A.A. or A.S. by the end of the semester. The application is due by April 15.
- 2. The recipient must enroll in a four-year college/university the following fall term.
- 3. The recipient must present a Letter of Acceptance by May 15, of the year, to receive the award. All correspondence must be mailed to the CaIRTA Tumbleweed Division No. 74 Scholarship Committee Member found at the end of this application.
- 4. Verification of enrollment in a four-year college/university must be provided to the CalRTA Tumbleweed Division Scholarship Committee Member by October 15, of the year of the award. If this is not accomplished by the appropriate date, the award will be forfeited.
- 5. Be a resident of the High Desert.
