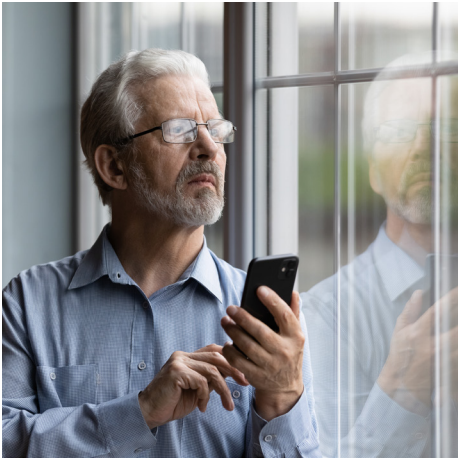


Active Assailant Response Program
