5.1 Director’s Updates

E. Rivera reports out that BACAE is excited to host graduation on May 16th and celebrate our graduates. E. Rivera reports out the idea of having two graduation ceremonies a year with one in December and one in Spring moving forward. E. Rivera shared that BACAE participated in two outreach events recently. The Cinco de Mayo Festival in Barstow and Route 66 Big Bash in Newberry Springs. BACAE is also launching K12 Pathways Paraeducator program again starting

on May 14th, 2026. All districts are welcome to spread the word and have their AE students attend.

5.3 Member Program Update: Barstow Adult School – **BUSD**

M. Colleoc reports BAC has 518 students registered, 356 currently enrolled, 35 students left to post test for the year. BAC expects 105 graduates this year. BAC is sending staff to the CASAS Summer Institute and GED Conference this year. BAC will be going dark after graduation for the summer.

5.4 Member Program Update: Barstow Community College - **BCC**

L. Alvarado reports on the current happenings of the College, CTE and Adult Education programs. E. Rivera reports the college is no longer going to complete CASAS testing for GED students, instead will be reporting data via MIS. Adult Ed. has requested for formal GED classes to be approved through the CCC process instead of GED workshops. E. Rivera reports conversations occurring with Newberry Springs and Hinkley regarding educational support in those communities. E. Rivera reports BCC and the Vibrant Villages project will be having listening sessions during the summer to further engage communities we serve. K. Corbo reports that we have 47 active students, 14 prospective students in progress, and 4 GED completers currently.

5.5 Member Program Update: **Baker Valley USD**

M. Esposito reports BVUSD has three adult school graduates this year and that classes are going well. Transportation continues to be a major issue for BVUSD. M. Esposito spoke about some of the opportunities around Baker for students related to employment. BVUSD Adult School will be going dark for the summer.

5.6 Member Program Update: **Silver Valley USD**

J. Youskievicz reports that SVUSD has about 60 students currently enrolled in their program. They are expecting 11-12 graduates this year for Adult Education. Adult Ed. graduation ceremony is scheduled for May 18. J. Youskievicz reported that the GED Testing Center will remain open this summer.
