- 5.2 TTA Update: Elena has been working with Ryan De La Vega on a weekly basis and have been reviewing the consortium members DIR. They are specifically working on the BCC DIR issues with registration information being inputted incorrectly and seeking to improve procedure.

5.3 CAEP Updates:

- District member attendance at the CAEP Summit is highly encouraged

5.6 BAS Member Program Update:

BAS Currently has 156 students for enrollment and 87 students have been CASAS tested while 69 students still need testing. 52 students in the high school diploma program and 21 students in the GED program. CASAS testing weekly and have rescheduled students 4 times for those who are interested but have yet to show. They are outreaching these students in various forms, text messages, phone calls, and emails. However, they are still having a difficulty getting students to show up for their CASAS testing appointments.

5.7 BCC Member Program Update:

78 students signed up for the non-credit CTE classes to date. Tutoring is offered to all fort Irwin students taking the Basic Skills classes. CTE is working with Adult Ed to help create a class were Adult Ed students can register for workforce skills workshops. BCC will be participating in numerous outreach events in the community to recruit new students. GED Prep in Spanish will start on January 10, 2022 and be CASAS tested, plus meet with a transitional counselor to create an Educational Plan. The Innovation & Entrepreneur continues to be in development. Currently, spaces at the BCC campus are being designed. CTE faculty is starting to write the curriculum for non-credit classes for the Innovation & Entrepreneur Center.

5.8 BVUSD Member Program Update:

BVUSD will be embedding the BCC CTE non-credit classes into their daily school schedule so their Adult Ed students will receive credit for their elective classes in their transcripts. The two new teachers have been trained to support their AE programs. It has been a great challenge to get the AE students back in the classrooms.

5.9 SVUSD Member Program Update:

SVUSD has 153 students enrolled in AE with 7 in ESL, and 2 are ready to graduate. The WASC final report was positive. SVUSD will know their official results in January 2022. 12 students have been tested in CASAS. It has been a struggle to get AE students CASAS test in-person or remotely. Flexible schedules are still offered in person or via Zoom. Ed2Go partnership is active, 12 students enrolled.

Terri Walked reported all invoices for November 2021 have been submitted for payment and will be sent out next month. All the checks through October have been cleared.


