- 5.2 TTA Update: E. Rivera last met with Ryan de la Vega in December 2021. Next meeting is scheduled for February 2022. In December 2021, E. Rivera met with the TTA leadership regarding about the experience with the TTA program and support. E. Rivera stated is has been beneficial and would like for it to continue.
- 5.3 \*CAEP Updates: CAEP Webinar: Three-Year Plan in NOVA Dec. 8, 2021
- 5.6 Member Program Update: BAS has 122 students enrolled, 86 in the High School diploma program and 36 in GED preparation, 24 students have been enrolled and are scheduled to take CASAS. M. Colleoc has completed GED certification to be the testing administrator for BAS. First GED test session is scheduled for January 29<sup>th</sup> 2022.
- 5.7 Member Program Update: BCC is working on increasing student enrollment in the non-credit CTE certificate classes for the spring semester. In the fall semester, BCC had 72 adult ed. students complete CTE non-credit classes as follows: 22 in Customer Services; 18 in Trade Technician; 13 in Cal OSHA Forklift Operations; 19 in Digital Literacy. Adult Ed. is looking into adding subtitles in Spanish to the CTE non-credit Customer Service class videos to engage ESL students. The AE department is collaborating with the Greater High Desert Chamber of Commerce to assist with job search for AE students. Their workforce development representative will be meeting with students twice a month starting in March. BCC AE is now providing GED preparation in Spanish in the TLSC. ESL has returned to Adult Education and in collaboration with Dr. Jennifer Rodden, will open an ESL Success Center. CASAS testing is resuming for ESL non-credit student as of January 10, 2022. BCC AE will partner with other departments to host an open house on April 30, 2022 for potential students to tour the college and have a STEAM family activity.
- 5.8 Member Program Update: BVUSD has 4 students currently signed up, however, some students are struggling to continue with their classes. Students are being offered additional hours at their employment. The AE team is currently strategizing on how to bring in more students. For example, how to offer morning and evening classes to accommodate those who work different shifts.
- 5.9 Member Program Update: SVUSD has had 6 students graduate. Currently, there are 173 students enrolled in AE but it has been a great challenge to have the students CASAS tested. Although remote testing and in-house testing is offered, students are not keeping their appointments or have a variety of barriers. At this time, there are 10 students enrolled in ESL. The student lab is now open 7 days a week to accommodate student needs.
- 5.10 BCC Fiscal Agent Report: All of January invoices have been paid. Baker has December check outstanding. C. Edwards will have it cleared immediately, delay due to resignation of CBO.


